

## Choose Life Fund Applicant Certifications

Ethics Certification: Revised Code 3517.13 and Governor's Executive Order 2007-01S.

Applicant hereby certifies and affirms that, as applicable to the applicant, no party listed in Division (I)(3) or (J)(3) of section 3517.13 of the ORC has made, as an individual, within the two previous calendar years, one or more contributions in excess of \$1,000.00 to the holder of the public office having ultimate responsibility for the award of the subsidy agreement or to the public officer's campaign committees and that all parties are in full compliance with Divisions (I)(1) and (J)(1) of O.R.C. Section 3517.13. If it is determined that the applicant's certification of this requirement is false or misleading, notwithstanding any criminal or civil liabilities imposed by law, the applicant shall return to ODH all monies paid to the applicant under this subsidy agreement. The provisions of this section shall survive the expiration or termination of this subsidy agreement.

In accordance with the Governor's Executive Order 2007-01S, applicant, by signature on this certification, also certifies: (1) applicant has reviewed and understands the Governor's Executive Order 2007-01S; (2) applicant has reviewed and understands the Ohio ethics and conflict of interest laws; and (3) applicant will take no action inconsistent with those laws and this Executive Order. The applicant understands that failure to comply with Executive Order 2007-01S is, in itself, grounds for termination of this subsidy agreement and may result in the loss of other contracts or grants with the State of Ohio.

Recovery Certification: Revised Code 9.24

Applicant affirmatively represents and warrants that it is not subject to a finding for recovery under section 9.24 of the O.R.C. or that it has taken the appropriate remedial steps required under section 9.24 of the O.R.C. or otherwise qualifies under that section.

Debarment Certification: Revised Code 125.25 and 153.02

Applicant further affirmatively represents and warrants that it is not debarred or suspended from entering into state of Ohio contracts pursuant to sections 125.25 or 153.02 of the O.R.C. Applicant agrees that if this representation and warranty is deemed false, the agreement will be void ab initio as between the parties to this agreement, and any funds paid to Applicant hereunder shall be immediately repaid, or an action for recovery may be immediately commenced for the recovery of said funds.
